

PRIVACY POLICY

The National Association of Managing Agents ("NAMA") ("us", "we", or "our") is a voluntary, Non-Profit organisation that promotes and advances Community Scheme Property Management in South Africa as well as the common interests of persons and entities engaged in the business of Community Scheme management ("Service(s)").

COOKIES 5.

Cookies are files with a small amount of data, which may include an anonymous unique identifier. We

use Functional Cookies that remember who you are as a user of our site. We use them to remember

any preferences you may have selected on our site, like saving your username, password or settings.

Cookies are sent to your browser from a website and transferred to your device. The Cookies are used

to collect information in order to improve our services for you.

You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. The Help

feature on most browsers provide information on how to accept cookies, disable cookies or to notify

you when receiving a new cookie.

If you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some features of our website and we

recommend that you leave them turned on.

If NAMA is involved in a merger, acquisition or asset sale, your Personal Information may be transferred

as a business asset. In such cases, we will provide notice before your Personal Information is transferred

and/or becomes subject to a different Privacy Policy.

The security of your Personal Information is important to us, and we strive to implement and maintain

reasonable, commercially acceptable security procedures and practices appropriate to the nature of

the information we store, in order to protect it from unauthorised access, destruction, use, modification,

or disclosure.

However, please be aware that no method of transmission over the internet, or method of electronic

storage is completely secure and we are unable to guarantee the security of the Personal Information

we have collected from you.
